Trai to begin consultation on spectrum issues

Auctions, reserve price valuation methodology, spectrum leasing, surrendering, trading to be taken up for discussion

New Delhi, November 28

TRAI CHAIRMAN R S Sharma said on Wednesday that after discussions with the telecom operators, the regulator has decided to come out with a consultation paper on the calculation methodology of reserve price for spectrum auction.

This was part of the Telecom Regulatory Authority of India's (Trai) deliberations with Vodafone Idea, Bharti Airtel and Reliance Jio, which is done every year to chart the authority's agenda for the upcoming calendar year.

"We met operators today to chalk out Trai's agenda for 2019. We have received their suggestions and based on which we will take up spectrum-related issues like policy



on auctions, reserve price valuation methodology, spectrum leasing, surrendering, trading, etc. We will bring a consultation paper which will have all spectrum issues," Sharma told reporters.

Besides these subjects, Sharma said that issues of fibreisation and related infrastructure, regulatory framework for Internet of Things (IoT), review of the Universal Service Obligation Fund (USOF) and designing of a broadband readiness index for states.

"The meeting today was important as now we have a new digital communications policy in place. There are lot of statements in the policy which will require deliberations. We wanted to consult with the telecom service providers to get their view point on key issues and subjects," Sharma added.

He also said that after the Trai to hold a consultation on the issue of high taxes and levies as well as GST refunds related to mobile phones, he said.

NGT panel to prepare plan for scrapping banned vehicles

THE NATIONAL GREEN TRIBUNAL has taken note of absence of a policy for dealing with scrapping of banned petrol and diesel vehicles and formed a committee to prepare it.

The tribunal noted that the Delhi government has deregistered 40 lakh vehicles, which include petrol vehicles that are 15-years-old and 10-years-old diesel vehicles, and they are being dumped in Mayapuri scrap market here.

The green panel directed the Delhi chief secretary to take steps and prepare an action plan for shifting the scrap yards from busy localities of the city to other appropriate locations, within three months.

It directed the chief secretary and the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) to furnish their separate report with regard to the action taken by March 31 next year.

It also said that after the scrap is shifted to a suitable location, the same may be handled, processed and disposed of as per the guidelines of the CPCB, which may issue such guidelines by January 31.

A bench headed by NGT chairperson justice Adarsh



Kumar Goel said the issue highlights the need for a proper scrapping policy and there was also a need for scrap handling, processing and disposal guidelines.

"Accordingly, we direct constitution of a joint committee headed by secretary, ministry of road transport, central government with representatives from the CPCB, environment ministry and the Delhi government to examine the matter and to prepare an appropriate scrapping policy."

"Such policy be prepared by concerned authorities within three months. The nodal agency for this purpose will be the secretary, ministry of road transport," the bench said.

The tribunal directed that the first meeting of the committee may be convened within one month.

It had earlier ordered

deregistration of 10-years-old diesel and 15-years-old petrol vehicles in the National Capital Region for causing air pollution.

The tribunal's order came after taking note of a newspaper report which referred to the absence of a policy and action for dealing with the scrapping of old vehicles which stand deregistered and consequent air pollution and environment degradation.

"The photograph in the newspaper shows large number of vehicles dumped in Mayapuri scrap market between C and E blocks. This has resulted in road space being occupied on account of open air metal dismantling workshops. Trucks are struck on the road for hours on account of this causing huge air pollution," the tribunal noted.

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PhD holders from top foreign varsities eligible for assistant professor job: UGC

NEW DELHI, November 28

DOCTORAL DEGREE HOLDERS from the top 500 foreign universities are now eligible for direct recruitment as an assistant professor in Indian varsities, according to the UGC.

As per the new recruitment norms, the top 500 ranking of the university shall be referred from famous world university ranking systems - Quacquarelli Symonds, Times Higher Education rankings and the Academic Ranking of World Universities of the Shanghai Jiao Tong University.

"The direct recruitment eligibility of international PhD holders is applicable for the disciplines of Arts, Commerce, Humanities, Education, Law, Social Sciences, Sciences, Languages, Library Science, Physical Education and Journalism and Mass Communication. This will help students learn from global talent in India itself," a senior UGC official said. Earlier, candidates eligible for the post were required to have minimum 55% marks in the Master's degree in concerned subject from an Indian University or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.

Engineering exporters expect shipment value to rise to 3 digits

AFTER HAVING ACHIEVED an all-time high of \$76.2 billion worth of engineering exports in FY18, and a 11.3% growth over the worth of exports done in the first 7 months of the current fiscal, Indian engineering exporters now aim at reaching a three digit level in their annual shipments.

Ravi Shegal, chairman of EEPIC India, the apex body of engineering exporters, at the 34th Eastern Regional Awards of EEPIC India said the Union commerce ministry has helped the exporters to a great extent by forming the Directorate general of trade remedies (DGTR). The directorate would provide trade defence not only to the domestic industry but also to exporters in dealing with increasing instances of investigations instituted against them by the importing countries.

"Dealing with non-tariff barriers needs government support that would be made available by the DGTR," Shegal said.

The EEPIC, however, expressed concerns over ambiguity on continuation of preferential system of preferences (GSP) for Indian Imports to the US. The GSP programme allows duty-free entry of 1,937 products worth \$5.6 billion from India into the US. This benefits the exporters of textiles, engineering, gems and jewellery and chemical products. But the tariff war between the US and China is possibly phasing out India's export promotion schemes and giving rise to trade protectionism in developed countries. This could however be a challenge in the growth of Indian overseas shipment in future, Shegal said.

The trade war, which is not between the US and China only, is finding some changing dynamics with demand supply once again coming to play. The shortage in supply of goods, both finished and raw material, is increasing the final consumption price, which will impact consumption and down the line export orders.
