The Independent Directors are provided with copy of latest Annual Report, the Code of Conduct for Directors and Senior Management, Company's Code under SEBI Prevention of Insider Trading Regulations.

A detailed appointment letter incorporating the role, duties and functions, remuneration and performance evaluation process and insurance cover is issued for the acceptance of the Independent Directors.

Quarterly presentations on operations made to the Board include information on business performance, operations, market share, financial parameters, working capital management, fund flows, senior management change, major litigation, compliances, subsidiary information, donations, regulatory scenario etc.

The Independent Directors are updated on a continual basis on changes/developments in the domestic/global corporate and industries scenario including those pertaining to statutes/legislations and economic environment.



The Independent Directors visit the registered office of the Company and interact with Senior Management Personnel. Presentations are given to them by vertical / practice heads for enabling a good understanding of the Company's operations vis a vis other competitors, vision and mission of the Company and global business environment.
