SWORD OF HONOUR AWARD FOR JRP & JBP (2011)

Jaypee Rewa Cement Plant (JRP) and Jaypee Bela Cement Plant (JBP) in Madhya Pradesh of the Group have been awarded with the coveted Sword of Honour. The Sword of Honour is a prestigious award given by the internationally acclaimed British Safety Council to the industry demonstrating the highest and best practices in Health, Safety and Environment. Both the plants had earlier been certified 'Five Stars' in the year 2009 and 2010.

For the year 2011, out of a total 72 applicants who had qualified for the BSC Five Star Certification, the Sword was given to only 54. Out of a maximum 72 marks the plants at Rewa Complex secured 68 marks i.e. 94.4% and were ranked 5th and 6th globally. This achievement is unique because JRP & JBP are the sole plants in the cement industry to be awarded the Sword and that too for a second time in a row i.e. 2010 and 2011.

The Swords for both the plants were received by Col (Retd) Ajai Singh, Sr. Vice President (HR) at a glittering ceremony at Goldsmiths Hall, London (UK) on 25 Nov 2011 and were presented by Mr. Alex Botha, CEO of British Safety Council.
